*Remember to always check the safety of someone in crisis  
"Do you currently feel safe where you are?"*

### REPORTABLES Non-Confidential Information



- Suspected or known child abuse/neglect
- Alleged domestic abuse
- Suspected or potential homicides, violence, or life-endangering situations
- Suspected or potential suicidal risks
- Alleged sexual assault
- Issues identified by the CO as reportable

### DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

- Life threatening situations call 9-1-1

### CHILD ABUSE

- In accordance with **Talia's Law**, within 24 hours, an Ombudsman must report to: California Child Welfare Services **800-344-6000**

- Report to your Chain of Command
