## Gym equipment: DRMO/Recycle proces


Logistics Defense Disposition Services (DLA Disposition Services) manages the Defense Reutilization and Marketing Office (DRMO) process for surplus military equipment, including gym equipment. When military units no longer require gym equipment, they can turn it in to DRMO, which assesses the items for reuse, recycling, or disposal. Reusable equipment is made available to other military units or federal agencies, while non-reusable items are recycled or disposed of in an environmentally responsible manner. This process ensures that surplus gym equipment is efficiently redistributed or recycled, supporting sustainability and costeffectiveness within the Department of Defense. Additionally, maintain copies of documents for their records and coordinate with the local DFS & DRMO office to ensure compliance with all procedures.

### PMS tip of the month

Maintenance should be conducted on a monthly basis in port and weekly while at sea. Ensure that all nuts and bolts are properly tightened, cables are secure and free from fraying, and treadmill belts are centered and tightly secured. Each command is required to have a repair technician, preferably an E-6 or lower, who is familiar with the equipment. If you need to assign a repair technician for your command, we offer a class twice a month that covers the basics of equipment maintenance.

## Maintaining Inventory: Expendable vs Non-expendable

Afloat recreation non-expendable property is NAF property with a useful life over two years and a cost greater than \$300, while expendable property has a useful life under two years or a cost under \$300. A physical inventory of NAF and APF property must be done semi-annually (within 30 days of 31 March and 30 September). Non-expendable property must have a unique identification number, listed on the Inventory Record with item details, serial number, acquisition cost, and date. Expendable property aboard ships is tracked by the RSO, including item name, quantity, and total value, but inventory numbers are not required.
